



Bridge Programs

- For individuals that need further skill development to begin a training program.
- Provides on-ramps to postsecondary education and training.
- Includes contextualized learning.

Addressing Barriers

"Goal 5: Barrier Remediation —Pennsylvania Department of Labor & Industry's policy on priority of service, identify an "individual with a barrier to employment" as a member of one or more of 14 populations, including low-income individuals, ex-offenders (also referred to as reentrants), longterm unemployed individuals, English learners and individuals facing substantial cultural barriers, single parents, and individuals with disabilities. Local workforce development areas across Pennsylvania also may develop strategies to better serve additional populations in their own local area or region."




Advancing in a Career Pathway


