Rating Scale:

- S(3) = Observed Success (the student-teacher's successful implementation of instruction and positive effect on student learning along the standard were evidenced during the practicum)
- $P(2) = Observed \ Potential$ (the student-teacher's potential to provide instruction and improve student learning along the standard was evidenced throughout the practicum)
- $\mathbf{D}(1) = \mathbf{Observed\ Difficulty}$ (the student-teacher's difficulty in providing instruction and improving student learning along the standard was evidenced throughout the practicum)
- **NO** = *Not Observed* (there is insufficient evidence available to determine level of performance)
